

Bible Study Guide on Exodus

Please use the English Standard Version (ESV) rendition of the English Bible for your study. Also please refer to to read the text of Exodus in a few other English renditions, such as the New International Version 2011 (NIV), New Living Translation (NLT), The Living Bible (TLB), New American Standard Bible (NASB), and even King James Version (KJV), and Young's Literal Translation (YLT), to aid in your understanding.

You may do your study using the soft copy. If you prefer to use the hard copy, then you will need an exercise book for your answers.
