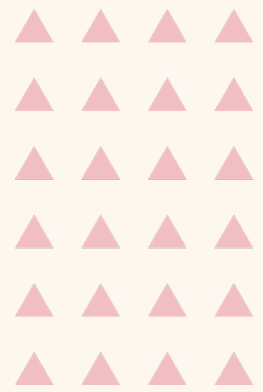


# FAQ about Relocation

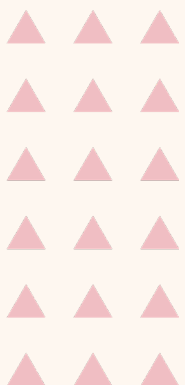


Hebron BPC will undertake major renovations of its facilities from 1 July 2024. This will require its worship services and other ministry activities to be held elsewhere.

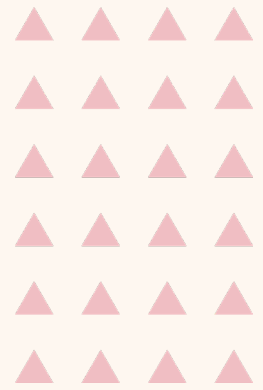
The following Frequently Asked Questions seeks to answer some of your concerns regarding the Hebron English congregations.

# FAQ about Relocation

Where will the Hebron English congregations gather for its weekend worship service?

All three of Hebron's English congregations will merge into one to worship at the premises of Bukit Panjang Gospel Chapel (BPGC) located at 12 Galistan Avenue Singapore 669686. There will be only one English worship service which will begin at 5pm and end by 6:30pm. Hebron will hold its first English worship service there on Sunday 7 July 2024.

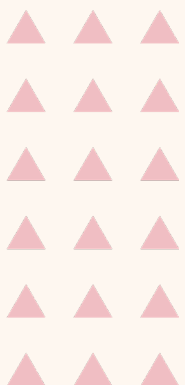
Where is the BPGC worship sanctuary located?

It is located at Level 2 of the building which is accessible by a lift and stairs.

What other Hebron activities will be held at BPGC?

BPGC has very graciously allowed Hebron to use their premises from 4pm to 8pm on Sundays, from July 2024. We will be able to run Children's Ministry activities concurrently with the worship service at 5pm. It is possible to have short ministry meetings between 4pm to 5pm in the classrooms as well as church-organised dinners at the fellowship hall after the worship service until 7:30pm, with time to pack up and vacate the premises by 8pm.

## How do I get there?

BPGC is accessible by car, bus and train.

MRT: the nearest is Bukit Panjang MRT station, 400m away



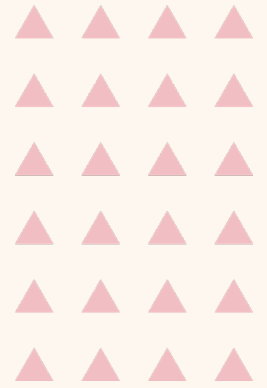
LRT: the nearest is Phoenix LRT station, 200m away



Bus: service numbers 67, 160, 180, 187, 190, 974, 975, 976, and 983 stop at bus stops along Choa Chu Kang Road, about 200m away



Car: to minimise vehicular traffic on-site, we will allow only cars bearing a handicapped label and the cars of external guest preachers to park on-site in the basement. All other cars should be parked at the nearby HDB estate at Block 158A Jalan Teck Whye. Please do not park along Galistan Avenue or any road that serves the nearby private houses.

## Is the walkway from the bus stop or train station sheltered?

No, the walkway is not sheltered. Please use an umbrella or wear headgear to shield yourself from the sun or rain.

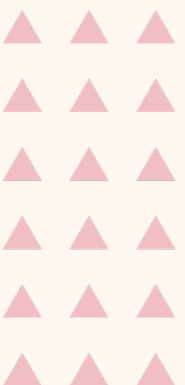

## Will Hebron provide bus transport or arrange car-pooling to and from BPGC?

We are seriously looking into providing bus transport from Yew Tee MRT station and Choa Chu Kang MRT station to BPGC and back, depending on the demand. A survey will be conducted in due course to determine the demand.

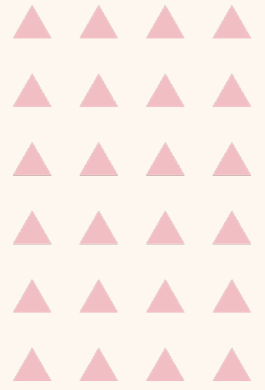
At the same time, this will be an opportunity for Hebronites who own cars to extend hospitality especially to those who may have difficulty travelling to and from BPGC by car-pooling. This is one way that we can use the assets that God has provided for us to bless our brothers and sisters in Christ.

## May we use the BPGC premises for week-night ministry meetings?

No, any ministry meeting that we wish to hold on BPGC premises will have to take place within the Sunday 4pm to 8pm time slot.

## How much will Hebron have to pay to BPGC for use of their premises?

BPGC will not charge Hebron rent but has asked Hebron to cover the cost of incidentals including utilities, cleaning charges, etc. We are grateful for their generosity.

## For how long will Hebron worship at BPGC premises?

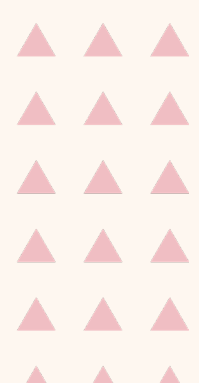
We hope to do so for the entire duration of our renovation period, which is expected to last between 18 to 24 months, subject, however, to BPGC's ministry needs that may change from time to time. We will be careful not to hinder BPGC's growth as a church when they let us use their premises.

## Will there be any adjustment to the order of service of the Hebron worship service when we relocate to BPGC?

We are already adjusting as we anticipate the limitations that we will face when we relocate. For example, we have implemented the Hebron BPC Digital Notice Board in order to reduce the number of ministry announcements to be given at the worship service and moved the Welcome/Family News segment to the start of the service. One more adjustment to be made will have to be for the benefit of Hebronites who will be serving at the Children's Ministry that will run concurrently with the sole worship service. More details about this will be announced in due course.

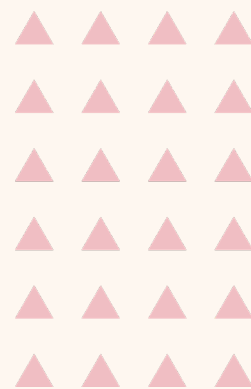
We should also be mindful that any adjustment that is made for the purpose of the relocation must not hinder our ability to function as multiple congregations when we return to our own premises eventually. Therefore, practices that are currently unique to a particular English congregation may continue. Please lovingly embrace these differences for the sake of our brothers and sisters in Hebron.

How will Hebronites who serve at the Children's Ministry which runs concurrently with the worship service get to worship at all?

We appreciate brothers and sisters who give of their time and gifts to serve and bless the children among us. We are still working out how to serve their spiritual needs through the worship service and will announce the details in due course.

How will the relocation impact access to pastoral care and counseling services usually provided at Hebron's facilities?

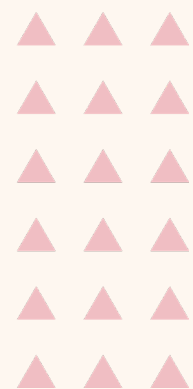
The pastoral team will be contactable by phone and can meet with Hebronites at any suitable place and time for such services. At the same time, Hebronites are urged to subscribe to the Hebron BPC Digital Notice Board so that information relating to the church especially during relocation is available at hand.

Will there be any adjustment to the timing or format of other regular church activities, such as prayer meetings or small group gatherings?

Generally, apart from the worship service and the Children's Ministry activities, the activities for youth, YAs, 49ers, KGs, SPA Bible classes, choir practice, etc. will be affected since BPGC premises will not be available outside of the Sunday 4pm to 8pm time slot for any other ministry activity. This season will give us an opportunity to be creative in the way we meet and practise hospitality to facilitate such meetings. At the same time, the leaders of these ministry departments will separately announce the alternative arrangements. ## How should Hebronites conduct themselves while using BPGC's facilities?

We must remember that BPGC is letting us use their facilities at the expense of possible ministry opportunity to their neighbours. Therefore, let us be considerate at all times in terms of noise, driving and parking, littering and cleanliness, and so on, and not cause inconvenience to them or their neighbours.
